

GROOMING GENERAL/ESTIMATED PRICING AND INFO.

These are general estimated starting prices only!

Final price is determined by the groomer.

Prices can vary depending on breed and size, condition of the coat, type of hairstyle, and temperament of the dog.

Full Groom

Haircut Dogs

Small dogs (1-20 lb.) - \$55-65

Medium dogs (21-50 lb.) - \$65-75

Large dogs (51-75 lb.) - \$75-85

Extra-large dogs (75+ lb.) - \$85 and up

Bath/Brush Out & Shedding Dogs

Small dogs (1-20 lb.) - \$35-55

Medium dogs (21-50 lb.) - \$45-55

Large dogs (51-75 lb.) - \$55-75

Extra-large dogs (75+ lb.) - \$65 and up

Mini Groom

Small dogs - \$35-45

Medium dogs - \$45-55

Large dogs - \$55-65

Extra large dogs - \$65-75

Departure Bath Only

Small dogs - \$25

A la carte & Add ons

Nail Trim Only - \$10

Medicated Shampoo - \$10

Extensive Brushing and De-matting - \$1 per minute

Ear Cleaning +/- Plucking - \$5-10

All first time dogs and dogs that haven't been groomed in over 8 weeks will be charged for a **Full Groom** unless different arrangements have been made with the groomer prior to the appointment time.

Mini Grooms are typically for dogs that are on a regular grooming schedule (every 6-8 weeks) but need a quickie bath and neaten up in between. No body hair is cut!

The **Departure Bath** is ONLY for dogs that are staying with us for boarding or daycare AND are on a regular grooming schedule of no more than every 8-10 weeks.

DeShed Treatment (Furminator) is included in the full groom price of shedding dogs. That is why the estimated price range varies by \$20. A smooth coated Chihuahua may be \$35, whereas a full coated Pomeranian or Sheltie may be \$55 due to the extra time it takes to fully deShed the dog.

Dematting is ONLY done if the matting is minimal and the pet will tolerate the process. We DO NO de-mat severely matted pets. We firmly believe that grooming should be a pleasant experience and should in no way be associated with pain or discomfort. If your pet is matted we will suggest a shave down and fresh start. If you do not want this you are welcome to take the pet home, brush out the mats so a metal comb will pass through the coat everywhere, and then bring the pet back for a full groom.
